Strengthening Working Families

How do I qualify?

- Must be in the third or fourth semester of a nursing program
- Be a custodial parent of a child 13 years old or younger or of a child with a disability
- Be unemployed or underemployed
- Have a high-school diploma and have completed FAFSA

What does the program offer?

- Participants can receive up to \$1,500 in financial assistance!

How do I qualify?

- Must be 18 years or older and have a diploma or GED
- Must reside in the 38126 zip code area of Memphis

What does the program offer?

- Participants can receive tuition assistance up to \$999 (depending on program selected) in the Dialysis Technician Program or EKG Tech Program.

How do I qualify?

- Must be 18 years or older and have a diploma or GED
- Verifiable residency in the Whitehaven area

- Support in acquiring NCRC credentials

- Must be 18 or older, have a diploma or GED
- Must enroll in and work towards a degree in childcare.

- Must be Pell-eligible
- Enrollment in 3 credit hours
- Good academic standing.

What does the program offer?

- Student-parents will receive greatly reduced childcare fees.

How do I qualify?

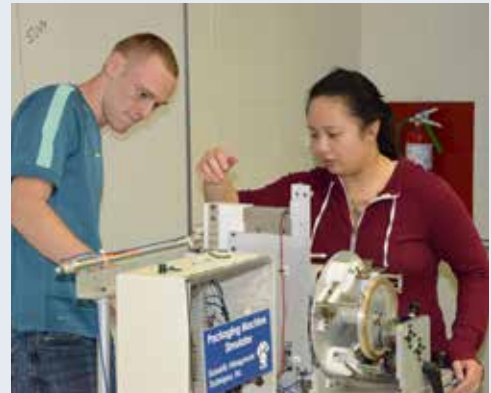
- Must be TAA-eligible
