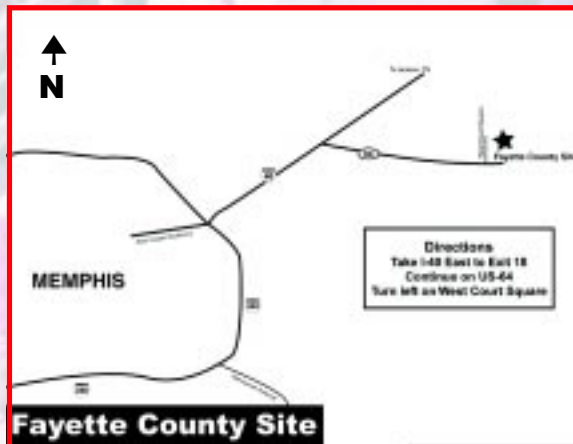

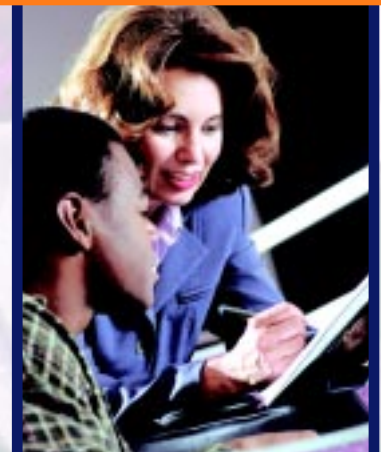

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

To anticipate and respond to the educational needs of the growing population of Fayette County, Southwest's Fayette Site, through its community partnerships, offers classes and student support services at two convenient locations: the Fayette County Career Center and Fayette-Ware Comprehensive High School.

To expand the availability of classes, the Fayette Site has two distance learning laboratories that allow students in Fayette County to be linked to a classroom at one of Southwest's main campuses. Southwest's vision for Fayette County is to build a full-service, comprehensive center for higher education that will offer a broad range of courses and degree programs.

DEGREE PROGRAMS

The Fayette Site offers courses in general education and academic development. General education courses include English, oral communication, mathematics, introductory biology, history, and social sciences. These courses meet the requirements for Associate of Applied Science degrees, Academic and Technical Certificates of Credit, and the Associate of Arts and Associate of Science degrees.



STUDENT SERVICES

Student services, including admissions/registration, records, academic advising, counseling, financial aid assistance, placement testing, parking passes, bookstore textbook sales, and bursar-cashiering, are offered by the College on a scheduled basis at the Fayette County Career Center. Students can call (901) 466-7656 or (901) 465-9838 after 3 p.m., for time and availability of services, and to make appointments.



FACULTY

Classes at the sites are staffed by full-time and adjunct faculty members dedicated to the student's success. Many of the faculty members are residents of the county. Small classes assure a more individualized approach and enable faculty members to serve as advisors, mentors and instructors.

DEVELOPMENTAL STUDIES

For students who need assistance with basic skills before beginning a degree or certificate program, a full complement of developmental courses is available at the Fayette Site. These developmental studies courses include basic math, elementary algebra, intermediate algebra, basic and developmental reading and writing, and developmental study skills.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Fayette County Career Center

Classes are scheduled Monday through Thursday from 4:30 p.m. to 10 p.m., and on Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Student services are available during hours when courses are scheduled to provide student assistance and by appointment. The computer lab is available for student use from 8 a.m. until closing.

Fayette-Ware Comprehensive High School

Classes are scheduled Monday through Thursday from 2 p.m. to 10 p.m. Student support services are available after 3 p.m., when courses are scheduled at this location.
