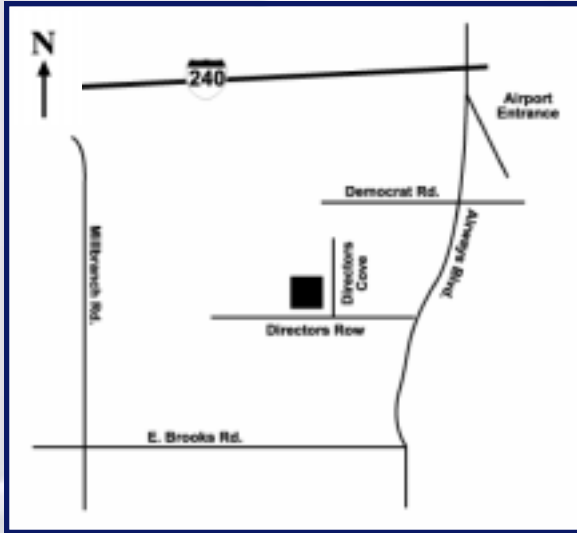

ACADEMIC PROGRAMS AND SERVICES

The Whitehaven Center fulfills the Southwest mission by offering conveniently located, state-of-the-art education opportunities to the Whitehaven community, including substantial areas in the southwest section of Memphis and Shelby County. Community partnerships enhance the center's ability to serve area residents.

The Whitehaven Center has served the community since 1978 in several locations, moving and upgrading facilities as the needs of residents require. Now located at 3035 Directors Row, the Center has expanded its space, adding seven 21st-century classrooms with access to current information and teaching technology.

DEGREE PROGRAMS

The Center offers career preparation in high-demand technology and business areas.

Associate of Applied Science degree programs:

- Information Technology/Generalist Concentration
- Office Administration/General Administrative Assistant Concentration

Technical Certificate:

- Computer Software Specialist

Associate of Science degree for university transfer:

- Business Administration is offered for university transfer.

A full range of General Education courses required for associate of arts, associate of science, and associate of applied science degree programs also is available on a regular basis. Courses include English (composition and literature), mathematics, social sciences, history, political science and speech. STUDENT SERVICES

All Student Services offered by the College are available on a scheduled basis at the Whitehaven Center, including financial aid, admissions, counseling, free tutoring, and student activities. Students can call the Center's administrative office, (901) 333-6450, for time and availability of services, and to make appointments.



FACULTY

Full-time faculty members are assigned to the Whitehaven Center and work diligently to provide consistency in relationships with our students. Southwest's policy of small classes helps instructors maintain one-on-one attention to all students. In addition to teaching, faculty are available as advisors and mentors to students.

LIBRARY

The Whitehaven Center offers full library facilities, including comfortable workspaces and computers for online and research needs. In addition to books and periodicals, the library provides access to a CD, DVD, and videotape library, and hosts weekly informational chats in order to keep our community aware of services available through the College. Students also have borrowing privileges at several college libraries in the metropolitan area.

DEVELOPMENTAL STUDIES

All courses in the Developmental Studies Department are offered each semester at the Whitehaven Center.

HOURS OF OPERATION

Classes are scheduled Monday through Friday from 7 a.m. to 10 p.m., and Saturday from 8 a.m. to noon.
