Milestone Courses

All courses marked are critical courses where a grade of C (77%) or higher is required to successfully complete the paramedic technical certificate and to be eligible to progress to the next level in this program.

General Advising Notes

This is a 12 month Special Admissions Paramedic Training Program. Paramedic core courses within each semester are co-reqs. Paramedic core courses must be completed sequentially.

Students must be licensed in the State of TN as an EMT Advanced to be considered for admission. Deadline to apply is July 1st (June 1st preferred.) Testing and an interview process are required for selection.

Helpful Hints 15 to FINISH

Take 15 credit hours a semester to finish your degree in two years.

General education classes to complete the degree may be taken prior to or after the core paramedic courses. Note that BIOL 1010 is a prereq for BIOL 1020. Also, Anatomy and Physiology I and II are preferred for medical professionals and may be substituted.
