1st Year

First Semester – Commit to Complete

Advising & SSP Coaching	Are you on track according to your academic plan? Have you made your Commitment to Complete? Make an appointment to see your Professional Academic Advisor (PAA) today! Stop by the HUB to meet your Saluqi Success Coach! <i>Download the My.Southwest App (click on the SSP icon) to stay informed.</i>
Testing Center	Get to know the Testing Center's Team! Test out of Learning Support classes to save time to degree completion.
Career Services	Make sure you are in the right major early. Stop by Career Services to take the Kuder and/or the Career Coach assessment(s).
Student Disability Services (SDS)	Did you have an IEP in high school? Are you feeling overwhelmed transitioning from high school to college? Register with the Office of Student Disability Services to receive your Letter of Accommodation and learn about Self Advocacy Transition Workshops!
Student Development	Want to learn more about getting involved on campus? There are 40 clubs and organizations (i.e. SGA, PTK, CAB, Diversity Club, Honors, SVO, etc.) at Southwest. Stop by to speak with the Student Development Team today.
Counseling & Social Services	Do you face challenges getting to your classes? Are you nervous about making new friends and meeting new people? Do you get anxious about taking quizzes and/or tests? Meet with our Counseling and Social Services Office to get connected to college and community resources.

Student Development	Still need Community Service or Service Learning Credit! Would you like to participate in intramural sports? Stop by the Student Development Office or Saluqi Success Pathway HUB to learn about opportunities in leadership, engagement, and advocacy.
